Dr. Nancy Reeves is a clinical psychologist from Victoria who has specialized in the area of trauma, grief and loss for 26 years. She is director of the Island Loss Clinic providing psychotherapy for children and adults, teaches a graduate course on Grief and Loss Counselling at the University of Victoria, conducts workshops throughout North America, New Zealand and Australia, and is author of the best selling book "A Path Through Loss."
